Welcome

Waxys is an expansive venue incorporating 6 bars over 3 floors with 9 total rooms. Directly in the heart of Glasgow right next to Queen Street train station. Hosting a wide selection of Scottish and Irish whisk(e)y's as well as a wide selection of 11 taps ranging from the classic Irish Guinness to the more fruitful Beavertown neck oil. We also boast a delicious Irish pub themed food menu with Guinness braised steak pies and traditional Irish fry ups!



At a Glance

3 Level Access

- The front entrance at West George Street is level with the sidewalk and is fully accessible to wheelchairs.
- There is level access from the West George street entrance to:

Murphy's Bar – pictured:



- Service lift for access to rest of venue.
- Outside seating area.

Access with steps

- There are steps from the Dundas Lane entrance into Dundas Bar with level access to Tablet Bar and the Cottage/Library rooms.
- Church Bar on the basement level of the venue is only accessible via stairs.
- Link Bridge area is only accessible via stairs from Murphy's bar, Dargle and Dundas (upper level)
- Small Church area is accessible via stairs from Church bar or Guinness Corridor.

Hearing

All staff have disability awareness training.

Wisual

• Signage displaying fire exits, Toilet directions and general bar and room labels.

• This venue has variable lighting and areas with lower lighting levels.

Q General

- There are 2 Disability access toilets in the venue: one on the upper level and one on the basement level.
- All staff have disability awareness training.

Getting here

Travel by public transport

- You can get to Waxy O'Connor's Glasgow by bus, train and metro.
- The nearest bus stop is right outside, just metres away, on West George Street. The bus stop is 0.0 miles / 0.0 km from Waxy O'Connor's.
- The nearest train station is Queen Street Station. We are also very close to Glasgow Central Station.
- The nearest underground station is Buchanan Street.
- We are located in the heart of Glasgow city centre, and well positioned for all forms of public transport.

Travel by taxi

• You can get a taxi with Glasgow Taxis by calling +44 (0)141 429 7070. The taxi company has a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

Parking

• There is a drop off point at the West George Street entrance for taxis but it is a bus/taxi gate from 10am until 7pm.

Arrival

Path to main entrance

- From the street to the main entrance (West George Street), there is level access.
- The path is 4267mm wide, or more.

Main entrance at West George Street

- The main entrance has level access.
- The main door is side hung and manual.
- Waxy O'Connor's is accessed via a wide pavement on West George Street. It is spacious inside with an accessible toilet on the basement and upper levels.

Getting around inside

Visual Impairment - General Information

- We have bold labels designating specific areas/rooms.
- Some parts of the venue have low/variable lighting.



Waxy O Connors

- From the main entrance to the bar, there is level access. The route is 950mm wide, or more.
- Access to the bar area is through a vestibule at the main entrance

HIS Public toilet

Accessible Toilet

- There is a public toilet for disabled visitors.
- From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access via an internal lift. The route is 950mm wide, or more.
- The toilet door is 900mm wide or more.
- The toilets have handrails.
- The toilet has A panic alarm that is connected to an emergency light on the outside of the toilet.

Place to eat and drink

- From the main entrance to the dining area, there is level access. To get to a table, there are no steps.
- The dining area is bar service. If you need table service, staff can help you.
- The route through the dining area is 800mm wide, or more.
- There is background music.
- The table and plates have high colour contrast.
- We cater for sugar free (diabetic), vegetarian, gluten free (celiacs), lactose free (dairy free), nut free, vegan, kosher and halal specific diets.
- Our venue has a menu that caters to all of the dietary requirements selected above. A full menu with dietary requirements is available via scanning the barcode on our menu, on our website or just by speaking to a member of staff.

Getting around outside

___ Smoking

Outside area

- From the main entrance at West George Street to the smoking area, there is level access. The route is 950mm wide, or more.
- The entrance is 1500mm wide.
